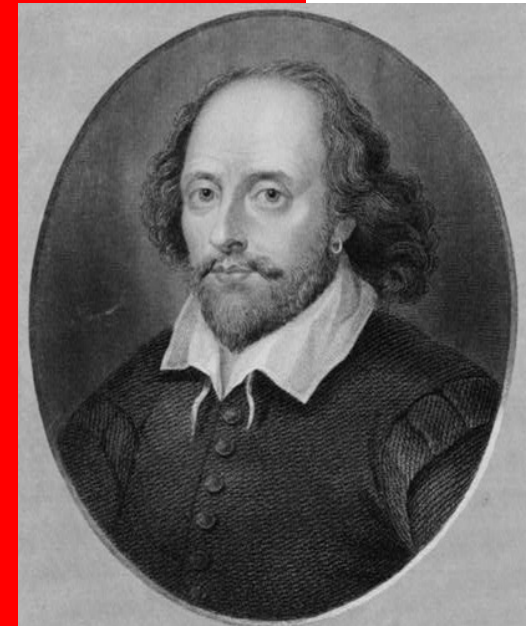

Ms. Zipay will present tools and techniques for unlocking Shakespeare's verse and creating vivid characterizations through exercises, improvisations, monologue and scene work.

JOANNE ZIPAY is the founder and Artistic Director of NYC's Judith Shakespeare Company, where she has served as director/dramaturg for over one-half of Shakespeare's canon to-date, including the entire 10-play History Cycle; Macbeth, winner of a 1996 OOB Award; and the acclaimed reverse-gender Julius Caesar, featured on national television's Lifetime Live.

Ms. Zipay has taught, directed, and performed in the theatre for almost 30 years, and holds a Master of Fine Arts degree from the classical acting program at the Old Globe Theatre/University of San Diego. She has studied with such eminent master teachers as John Barton, Richard Easton, Cicely Berry, Patsy Rodenburg, Larry Moss, and Stella Adler; and she has taught for the National Shakespeare Conservatory, Dallas Theatre Center, Old Globe Theatre, Princeton Repertory Shakespeare Festival, Brooklyn Academy of Music, Theatre for a New Audience, Stella Adler Conservatory, and numerous colleges and universities.

In 2009, she directed the NYC Off-Broadway premiere of Timothy Findley's Elizabeth Rex, and in 2008 was Master of Verse for the Richmond Shakespeare Festival in Virginia.

At Collin College, Ms. Zipay directed last summer's Comedy of Errors, and has co-directed and/or dramaturged Titus Andronicus, Julius Caesar, Twelfth Night, A Midsummer Night's Dream, and All's Well that Ends Well. She is currently on faculty at Pace University Manhattan.
